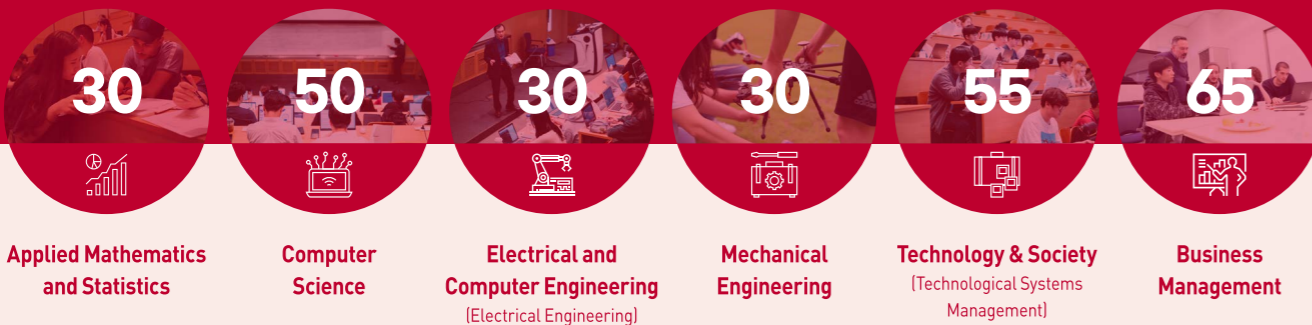
SCHEDULE & QUOTA

Fall Admission

- Classes Start: Late August
- Application Period: October/November of Previous Year ~ July/August

Spring Admission

- Classes Start: Late February
- Application Period: July/August of Previous Year ~ January/February



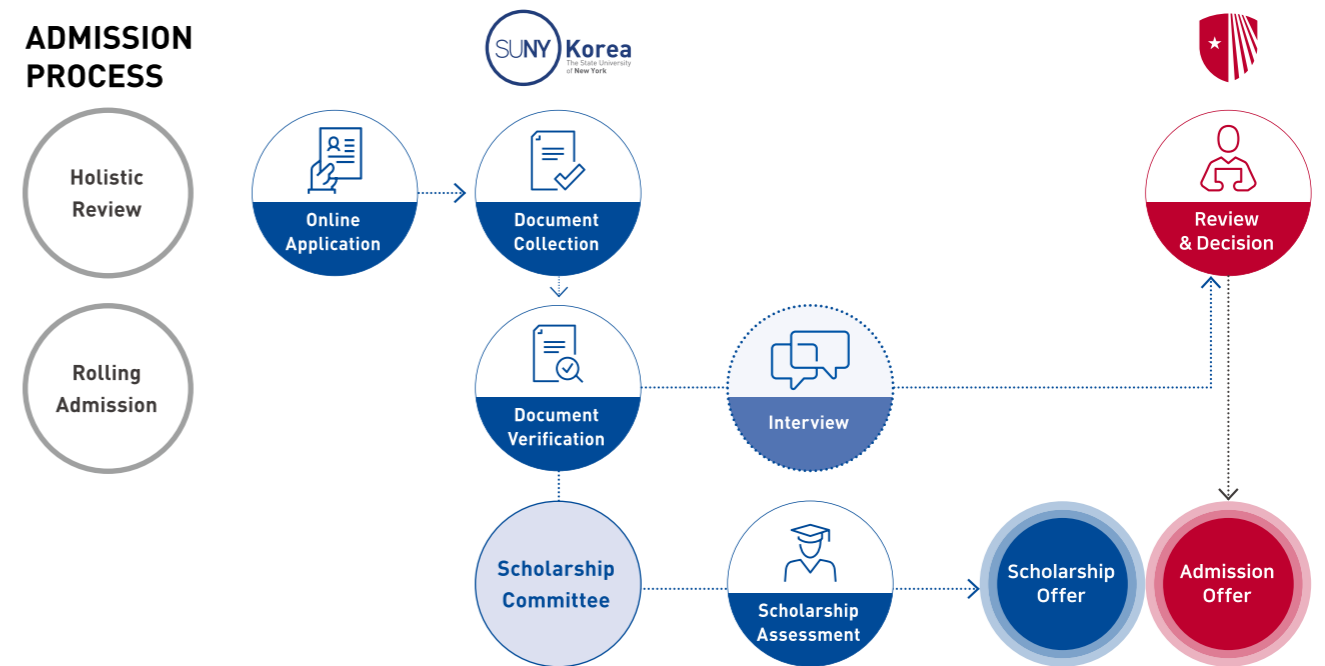
APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

- Required**
- High School Transcript**
 - Korean/US GED is accepted; GED-certified applicants are advised to submit other credentials
 - Transfer admissions applicants are required to submit the academic transcript of the college they attended.
 - Applicants who earned 24 college credits or more are not required to submit high school transcripts
 - Personal Statement**
 - A form is provided in the online application on the SUNY Korea webpage. (Word count limit: 650)
 - Applicants with gap years are recommended to provide relevant explanations.
 - Applicants may submit optional essays through the application form.
 - Letter of Recommendation**
 - Employees of private academies or SUNY Korea faculty/staff may not be accepted as a referee.
 - An electronic form will automatically be sent to the referee(s) by email once applicants enter the contact information in the application form.

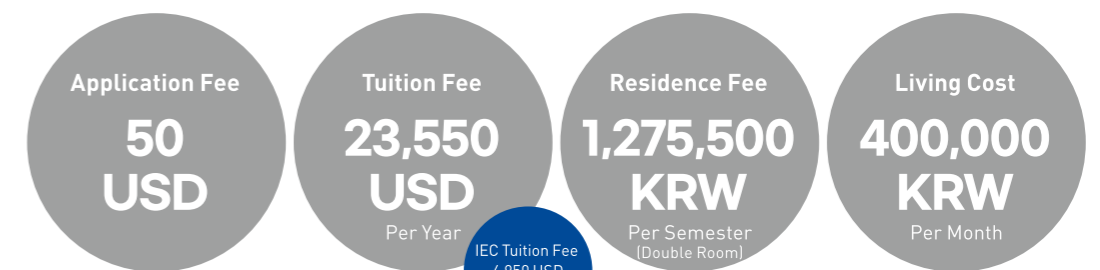
